### Pinoli Pine Nut Plantation & Factory visit

After two delays due to bad weather, the planned visit to the Pinoli pine nut plantation finally went ahead on Sunday November 14<sup>th</sup>.

A great turnout of around 30 cars and 60 people attended from both Nelson and Blenheim, we were all pleased to be going out after all our problems with Covid lockdown, road closures etc.

Lee Paterson, one of the originators and shareholders of the business, showed us around the processing plant and gave a very informative talk about how the nuts were grown, harvested, and processed.

A lot of expensive machinery required to get those wee nuts ready for sale, after the "kiwi way" of opening the pinecones on concrete in the sun.

They are working on finding markets for all the residual pinecones and husks remaining, but need to build up to a larger amount, so at present all waste is recycled back into the orchard.

Our visit was to the plantation in Wairau Valley, but there are also trees grown in Waihopai Valley and the largest area is out at Cape Campbell.

After our talk we were able to purchase packs of nuts, there was no shortage of takers, so happy buyers and happy seller.

The weather had held off all day, just threatening, but the skies opened just as we were leaving, so many got a bit wet in the dash for their cars.

A really enjoyable day, and many thanks to Wayne Bell and Pat Clay for organising this.


